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## USDA Designates 9 Wyoming Counties as Primary Natural Disaster Areas Due to Wildfires

**Emergency Designation | Colorado | November 01, 2024**

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This Secretarial natural disaster designation allows the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) to extend much-needed emergency credit to producers recovering from natural disasters through [emergency loans](#). Emergency loans can be used to meet various recovery needs including the replacement of essential items such as equipment or livestock, reorganization of a farming operation, or to refinance certain debts. FSA will review the loans based on the extent of losses, security available, and repayment ability.

**Impacted Area:** Wyoming

**Triggering Disaster:** Wildfires that started June 11, 2024

**Application Deadline:** June 16, 2025

**Primary Counties Eligible:** Albany, Converse Crook, Goshen, Hot Springs, Johnson, Platte, Sheridan, and Weston

**Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:**

**Wyoming:** Big Horn, Campbell, Carbon, Fremont, Laramie, Natrona, Niobrara, Park, and Washakie

**Colorado:** Jackson and Larimer

**Montana:** Big Horn, Carter, and Powder River

**Nebraska:** Banner, Scotts Bluff, and Sioux

**South Dakota:** Butte, Custer, Lawrence, and Pennington
