



USDA Announces Availability of Low-Interest Physical Loss Loans for Producers Affected by Natural Disasters in Texas

New Mexico

Physical loss loans through the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) can help producers repair or replace damaged or destroyed physical property essential to the success of the agricultural operation, including livestock losses. Examples of property commonly affected include essential farm buildings, fixtures to real estate, equipment, livestock, perennial crops, fruit and nut bearing trees, and harvested or stored crops and hay.

Triggering Disaster: Wildfire

Application Deadline: 12/01/2025

Primary Counties Eligible:

- **Texas:** Gray and Roberts

Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:

- **Texas:** Armstrong, Carson, Collingsworth, Donley, Hansford, Hemphill, Hutchinson, Lipscomb, Ochiltree, and Wheeler
- **Additional State:** List Counties

Triggering Disaster #2

Impacted Area: Texas and New Mexico

Triggering Disaster: High Winds

Application Deadline: 12/01/2025

Primary Counties Eligible:

- **Texas:** Deaf Smith and Hale

Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:

- **Texas:** Castro, Crosby, Floyd, Hockley, Lamb, Lubbock, Oldham, Parmer, Potter, Randall, and Swisher
- **New Mexico:** Curry and Quay
