



## **USDA Announces Availability of Low-Interest Physical Loss Loans for Producers Affected by Hail, High Winds, Lightning, Excessive Rain, Flash Flooding, Flooding, and Tornadoes**

**Emergency Designation | Oklahoma | April 29, 2025**

Oklahoma

Physical loss loans through the United States Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) can help producers repair or replace damaged or destroyed physical property essential to the success of the agricultural operation, including livestock losses. Examples of property commonly affected include essential farm buildings, fixtures to real estate, equipment, livestock, perennial crops, fruit and nut bearing trees, and harvested or stored crops and hay.

**Impacted Area:** Arkansas, Missouri, and Oklahoma

**Triggering Disaster:** Hail, High Winds, Lightning, and Tornadoes that occurred March 14 through March 16, 2025

**Application Deadline:** December 29, 2025

**Primary Counties Eligible: Arkansas-** Baxter, Clay, Fulton, Greene, Hot Spring, Independence, IZard, Jackson, Lawrence, Marion, Randolph, Searcy, Sharp, Stone, White, Woodruff.

**Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:**

**Arkansas:** Boone, Clark, Cleburne, Craighead, Cross, Dallas, Faulkner, Garland, Grant, Lonoke, Monroe, Montgomery, Newton, Poinsett, Pope, Prairie, St. Francis, Saline, Van Buren

**Triggering Disaster 2:** Excessive Rain, Flash Flooding, Flooding, Hail, High Winds, Lightning, and Tornadoes that occurred March 30, 2025 and continuing

**Application Deadline:** December 29, 2025

**Primary Counties Eligible:** Arkansas, Baxter, Boone, Clay, Cleburne, Craighead, Crawford, Cross, Fulton, Greene, Independence Izard, Jefferson, Lawrence, Marion, Newton, Prairie, Pulaski, Randolph, Searcy, Sharp, Stone, White, Yell

**Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:**
