Administrator's Physical Loss Notifications N1819

On April 28, 2025, Farm Service Agency Administrator, William L. Beam, signed an Administrator's Physical Loss Notification due to the excessive rain, flash flooding, flooding, hail, high winds, lightning, and tornadoes that affected several counties in Arkansas from March 14, 2025, through March 16, 2025.

Administrator's Physical Loss Notification N1819:
