



## USDA Designates Seven Minnesota Counties as Primary Natural Disaster Areas

**Emergency Designation | September 09, 2021**

This Secretarial natural disaster designation allows the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) to extend much-needed emergency credit to producers recovering from natural disasters through [emergency loans](#). Emergency loans can be used to meet various recovery needs including the replacement of essential items such as equipment or livestock, reorganization of a farming operation or the refinance of certain debts. FSA will review the loans based on the extent of losses, security available and repayment ability.

**Impacted Area:** Minnesota

**Triggering Disaster Event:** Drought

**Application Deadline:** April 27, 2022

**Primary Counties Eligible:** Big Stone, Brown, Carlton, Murray, Nicollet, Sibley and Swift
