



USDA Designates Seven Texas Counties as Primary Natural Disaster Areas

This Secretarial natural disaster designation allows the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) to extend much-needed emergency credit to producers recovering from natural disasters through [emergency loans](#). Emergency loans can be used to meet various recovery needs including the replacement of essential items such as equipment or livestock, reorganization of a farming operation or the refinance of certain debts. FSA will review the loans based on the extent of losses, security available and repayment ability.

Impacted Area: Texas

Triggering Disaster: Excessive moisture that occurred between Jan. 1, 2021, and July 31, 2021.

Application Deadline: July 5, 2022

Primary Counties Eligible: Calhoun, Colorado, Delta, Falls, Floyd, Hopkins and Victoria
