## **USDA Designates Coke County, Texas, as a Primary Natural Disaster Area Emergency Designation | February 17, 2022**

This Secretarial natural disaster designation allows the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) to extend much-needed emergency credit to producers recovering from natural disasters through [emergency loans](#). Emergency loans can be used to meet various recovery needs including the replacement of essential items such as equipment or livestock, reorganization of a farming operation or the refinance of certain debts. FSA will review the loans based on the extent of losses, security available and repayment ability.

**Impacted Area:** Texas

**Triggering Disaster:** A winter storm, blizzard, snow, ice, and high winds that occurred during Feb. 10, 2021, through Feb. 19, 2021.

**Application Deadline:** Oct. 11, 2022

**Primary County Eligible:** Coke

**Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:** Mitchell, Nolan, Runnels, Sterling and Tom Green
