



## **USDA Designates 14 Kentucky Counties as Primary Natural Disaster Areas**

**News Release | Kentucky | November 29, 2022**

This Secretarial natural disaster designation allows the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) to extend much-needed emergency credit to producers recovering from natural disasters through [emergency loans](#). Emergency loans can be used to meet various recovery needs including the replacement of essential items such as equipment or livestock, reorganization of a farming operation or the refinance of certain debts. FSA will review the loans based on the extent of losses, security available and repayment ability.

**Impacted Area:** Kentucky

**Triggering Disaster:** Excessive rain, landslides, flooding, and flash flooding that occurred from July 26 through July 29, 2022

**Application Deadline:** June 26, 2023

**Primary Counties Eligible:** Breathitt, Lee, Martin, Perry, Floyd, Leslie, Morgan, Pike, Johnson, Letcher, Owsley, Wolfe, Knott and Magoffin

**Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:**

**Kentucky:** Bell, Estill, Lawrence, Powell, Clay, Harlan, Menifee, Rowan, Elliott and Jackson

**Virginia:** Buchanan, Dickenson and Wise

**West Virginia:** Mingo and Wayne
