## **USDA Designates Four Illinois Counties as Primary Natural Disaster Areas**

This Secretarial natural disaster designation allows the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) to extend much-needed emergency credit to producers recovering from natural disasters through <a href="mailto:emergency loans">emergency loans</a>. Emergency loans can be used to meet various recovery needs including the replacement of essential items such as equipment or livestock, reorganization of a farming operation or the refinance of certain debts. FSA will review the loans based on the extent of losses, security available and repayment ability.

Impacted Area: Illinois

Triggering Disaster: Excessive moisture and flash flooding that occurred from July 26 through

August 12, 2022

**Application Deadline**: July 21, 2023

**Primary Counties Eligible:** Edwards, Jefferson, Washington and Wayne

## **Contiguous Counties Also Eligible:**

Illinois: Clay, Clinton, Franklin, Hamilton, Marion, Perry, Randolph, Richland, St. Clair, Wabash and White
