



Presidential Major Disaster Declaration Issued for Lee County, Iowa **News Release | Iowa | September 15, 2023**

Iowa

A Presidential Major Disaster Declaration has been issued naming nineteen (19) primary disaster counties in Illinois. Additionally, Lee County, Iowa has been named as contiguous to the disaster area. This determination will allow the Farm Service Agency's Emergency Loans to be made available to eligible family farmers with qualifying production and physical losses in the primary and the contiguous counties to the declared disaster area.

Presidential Declaration Number: M4728

Emergency Loan Application Deadline: May 25, 2024

Primary Counties Eligible: Primary county(ies) located in Illinois

Contiguous Counties Also Eligible: Lee County (Iowa)

Disaster Description: Severe Storms and flooding that occurred on July 29 - July 2, 2023
