



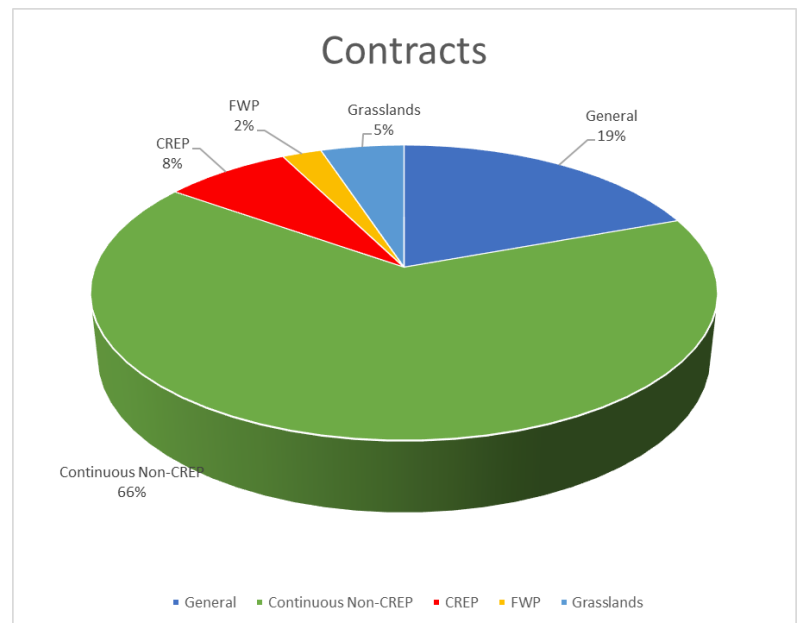
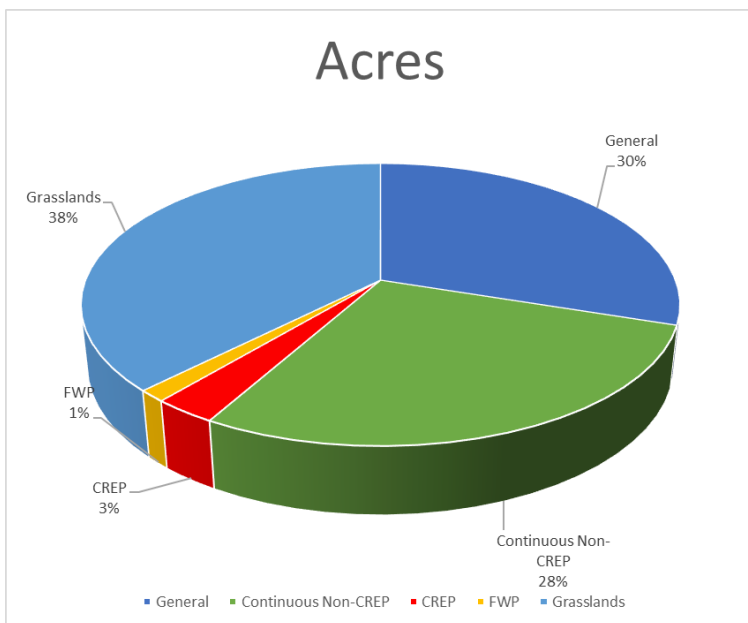

General Signup. Producers with eligible lands compete nationally for acceptance based on an environmental benefits index (EBI) during specified enrollment periods. Producers may submit offers below soil-specific maximum rental rates and select wildlife-enhancing vegetative covers to increase EBI ranking.

Continuous (Non-CREP) Sign-up. Producers with eligible lands may enroll certain high priority conservation practices, such as filter strips, riparian buffers, and wetlands at any time during the year without competition. In addition to annual soil rental payment and cost-share assistance, many practices are eligible for additional annual and one-time up-front financial incentives.

Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP). Under CREP, federal funds are supplemented with non-federal funds from eligible partners to implement projects designed to address specific environmental objectives through targeted CRP enrollment. Eligible partners provide matching contributions such as cash, in-kind contributions, or technical assistance. Eligible producers may enroll eligible land any time during the year.

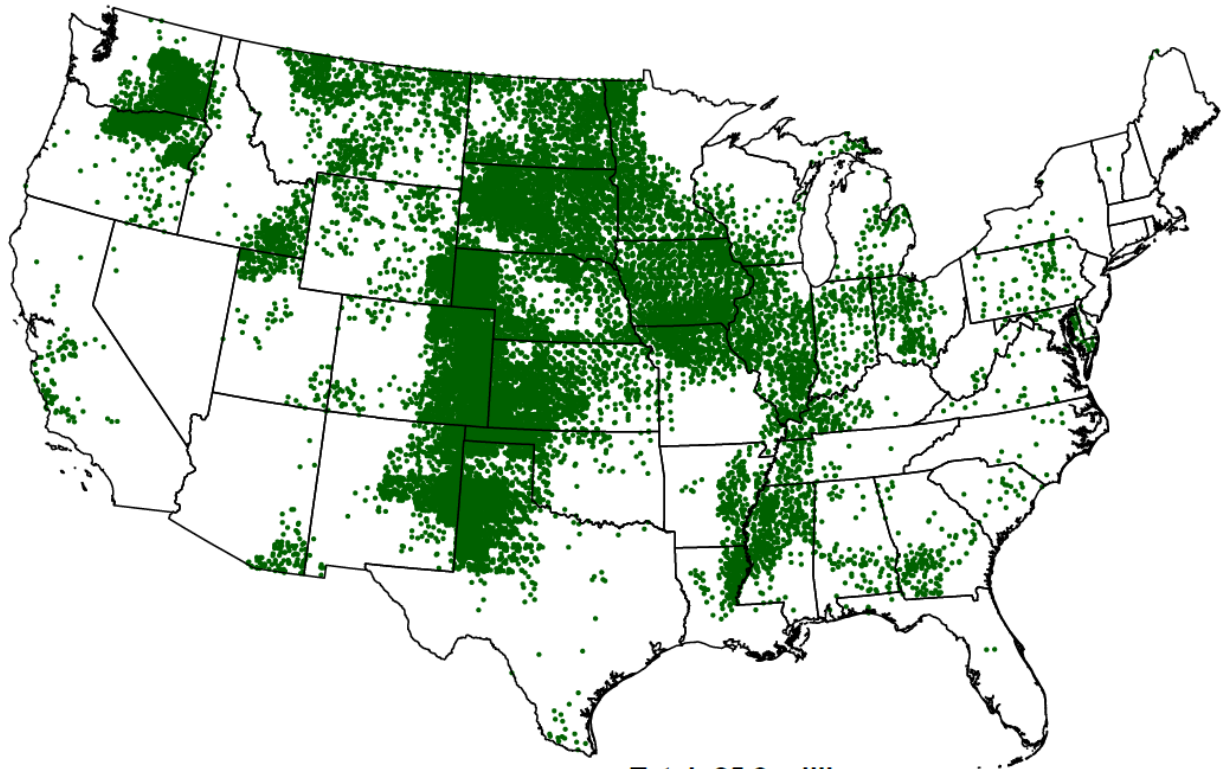
Farmable Wetland Program (FWP). Producers enroll small non-flood plain wetlands, and new practices added by the 2008 Farm Bill, under modified continuous sign-up provisions.

Grasslands. Enrollments are to support grazing operations and to preserve grasslands. No cropping history is required.

The accompanying tables are based on contract data developed and maintained in CRP data files by USDA Service Centers through the **end of May 2025** and are based on the physical location of the CRP contracted land. Some adjustments have been made to correct miscoded data in the active contract files.

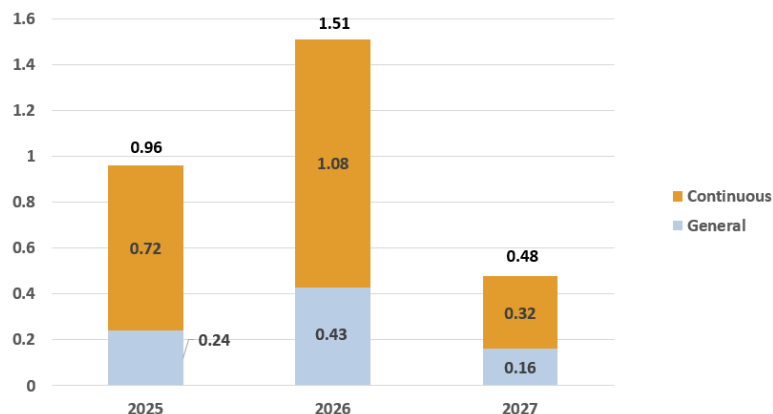

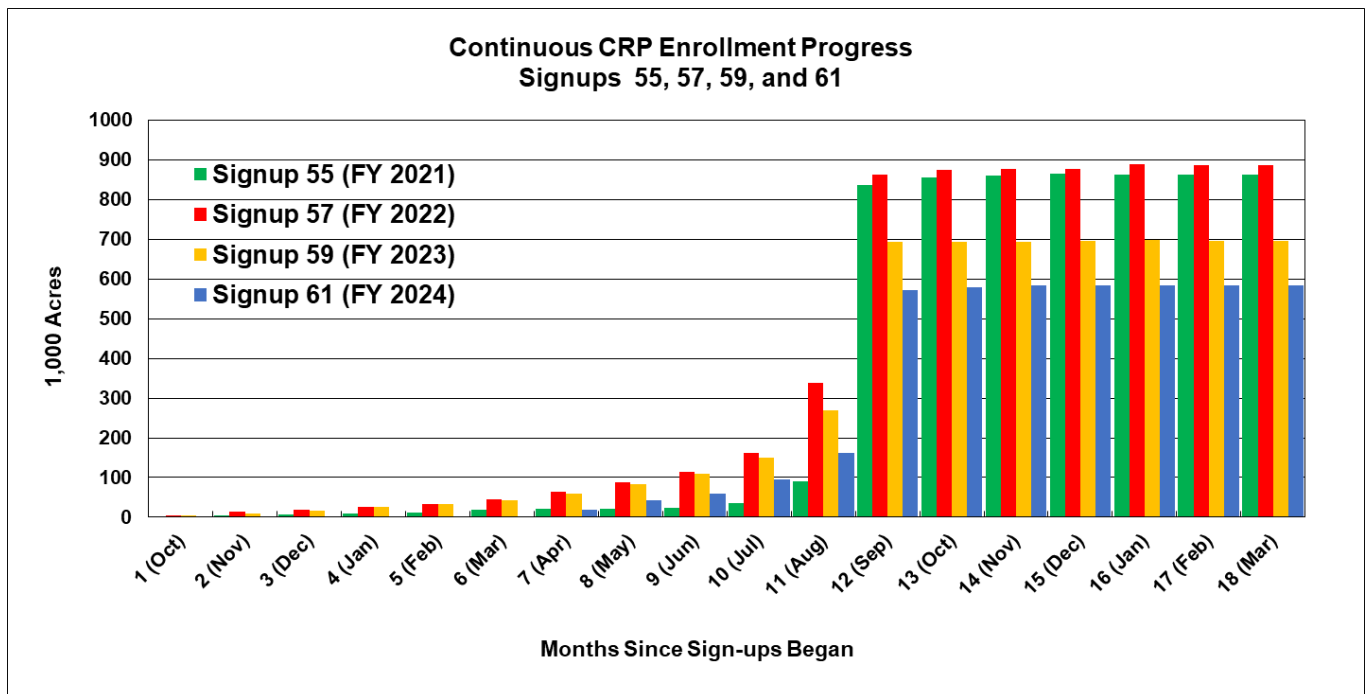

ENROLLMENT ACTIVITY AND NEWS – MAY 2025

- Enrollment ends May 2025 at 25.9 million acres.
- FY 2025 continuous signup (#63) opened May 12, 2025.
- General signup (#64) opened May 12, 2025, and will be held through June 6, 2025.
- Grasslands signup (#206) closed June 28, 2024, at 1.44 million acres accepted. These contracts became effective October 1, 2024.



Signup 61 peaked at 584,331 acres.
