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FOREWORD

Beet processors, cane processors, and cane refiners in the United States are required by the Federal Agriculture Improvement and Reform Act of 1996, as amended, to report data on physical quantities of stocks, production, imports, sales, and inventory adjustments to the Farm Service Agency (FSA) on a monthly basis. These data are compiled to produce the monthly Sweetener Market Data (SMD) report. Commercial sugar users, distributors, and traders are not required to report their stocks, imports, or exports data.

Starting with the SEPTEMBER 2011 SMD report, “Refined Imports” reflect “Total Imports” (as posted by the Foreign Agricultural Service (FAS) http://www.fas.usda.gov/smi_arc.asp) less “Cane Refiner Raw Imports” (as reported to FSA by cane refiners). This is a return to the method used in FY 2008 through FY 2010.

Explanation of Revisions to FY 2020-FY2026 Tables

In November 2025, USDA initiated interviews with sugarcane processors, sugar beet processors, and cane refiners who report monthly data to produce the Sweeteners Market Data (SMD) tables regarding an anomaly in the Fiscal Year 2025 sales and receipts data items. While reviewing their sales and receipts data, a company discovered longstanding errors in their monthly SMD reporting that impacted delivery and stock data items. The company approached USDA in June 2026 to disclose these errors.

The company has been incorrectly reporting data items since Fiscal Year 2020, requiring monthly revisions to SMD data starting in October 2019 to April 2026. On average, deliveries were underreported each month during this time period by 0.21 percent. However, because the company calculated ending stocks (as opposed to reporting physical inventories), the amount of overreported stocks accumulated each month, resulting in overreported stocks of 145,870 STRV once the error was discovered in Fiscal Year 2026. Table 1 below shows the changes to ending stocks since Fiscal Year 2020:

SMD reporters are instructed to report *physical* ending stocks each month rather than calculating ending stocks using supply and use variables to avoid this type of error. USDA worked with the company to revise FYs 2020 – 2026 SMD tables and counseled them on how to correctly report deliveries and stocks moving forward. USDA is confident that revisions have rectified the error and will continue to monitor the situation.

- **California Sugars was added to the SMD in April 2026 with the February 2026 data submission.**

- Tables 5-A through 5-E are production estimate model tables.
These tables show aggregate fiscal year sugar production estimate data submitted by all U.S. sugar beet and sugarcane processors. USDA uses the sugar production estimate data to administer the Sugar Marketing Allotment Program.

While these values are used to adjust sugar marketing allotments, they are not official USDA estimates, which are published monthly in the World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates by USDA's World Board. USDA has studied the accuracy in processor estimates, which varies through the growing season and is not consistent among sectors (see Cornell 2008 Sugar and Sweeteners Outlook <http://usda.mannlib.cornell.edu/usda/ers/SSS//2000s/2008/SSS-01-29-2008.pdf>).

- Regions on tables 8 and 10 are defined as:

New England - Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, and Connecticut.

Middle Atlantic - New York, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania.

North Central - Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Missouri, North Dakota, South Dakota, Nebraska, and Kansas.

South - Delaware, Maryland, District of Columbia, Virginia, West Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, Florida, Kentucky, Tennessee, Alabama, Mississippi, Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, and Texas.
