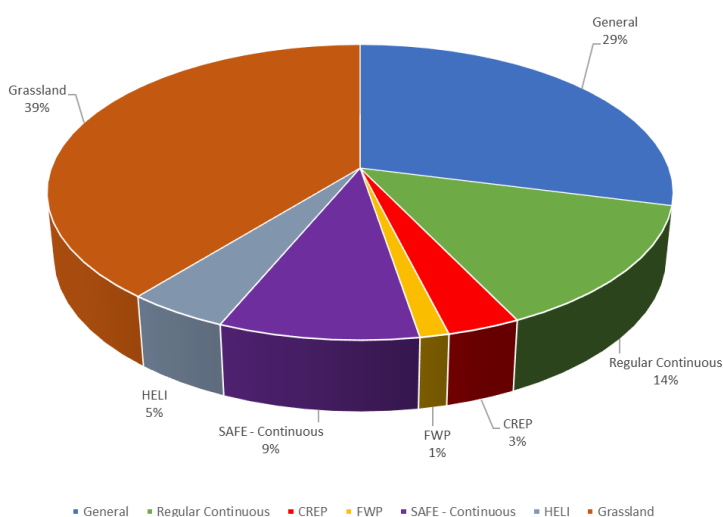

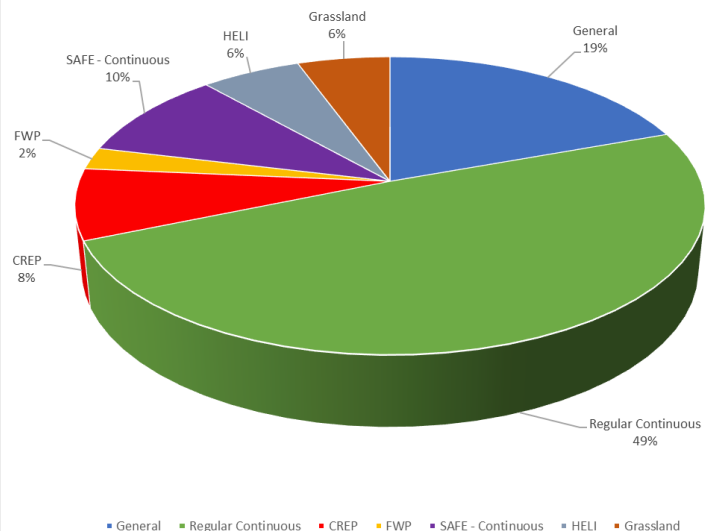

Glossary

General Signup. Producers with eligible lands compete nationally for acceptance based on an environmental benefits index (EBI) during specified enrollment periods. Producers may submit offers below soil-specific maximum rental rates and select wildlife-enhancing vegetative covers to increase EBI ranking.

Regular Continuous Sign-up. Producers with eligible lands may enroll certain high priority conservation practices, such as filter strips, riparian buffers, and wetlands at any time during the year without competition. In addition to annual soil rental payment and cost-share assistance, many practices are eligible for additional annual and one-time up-front financial incentives.

Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP). Under CREP, federal funds are supplemented with non-federal funds from eligible partners to implement projects designed to address specific environmental objectives through targeted CRP enrollment. Eligible partners provide matching contributions such as cash, in-kind contributions, or technical assistance. Eligible producers may enroll eligible land any time during the year.

Grasslands. Producers with eligible lands may enroll grassland, including rangeland, pastureland, and certain other lands, while maintaining the areas as grazing lands. Enrollments support grazing operations and preserve grasslands. No cropping history is required.

Transition Incentives Program. This program assists with the transition of expiring Conservation Reserve Program land from an owner to a beginning, veteran, or socially disadvantaged farmer or rancher to return land to production for sustainable grazing or crop production. Up to two additional annual rental payments are provided to the expiring CRP landowner.

Clean Lakes, Estuaries, And Rivers (CLEAR). A part of Continuous Sign-ups, the Clean Lakes, Estuaries and Rivers (CLEAR) initiative prioritizes water quality practices on the land that helps reduce sediment loss, nutrient loss, and harmful algal blooms. The vegetative covers also contribute to increased wildlife populations.

State Acres for Wildlife Enhancement (SAFE). A part of Continuous Sign-ups, the State Acres for Wildlife Enhancement (SAFE) Initiative restores vital habitat to meet high-priority state wildlife conservation goals. Landowners establish wetlands, grasses, and trees designed to enhance important wildlife populations by creating critical habitat and food sources. They also protect soil and water health by working as a barrier to sediment and nutrient run-off before they reach waterways.

Farmable Wetlands Program (FWP). Producers restore farmable wetlands and establish conservation practices to improve environmental health. The program targets specific areas of non-floodplain wetlands that are suitable for restoration

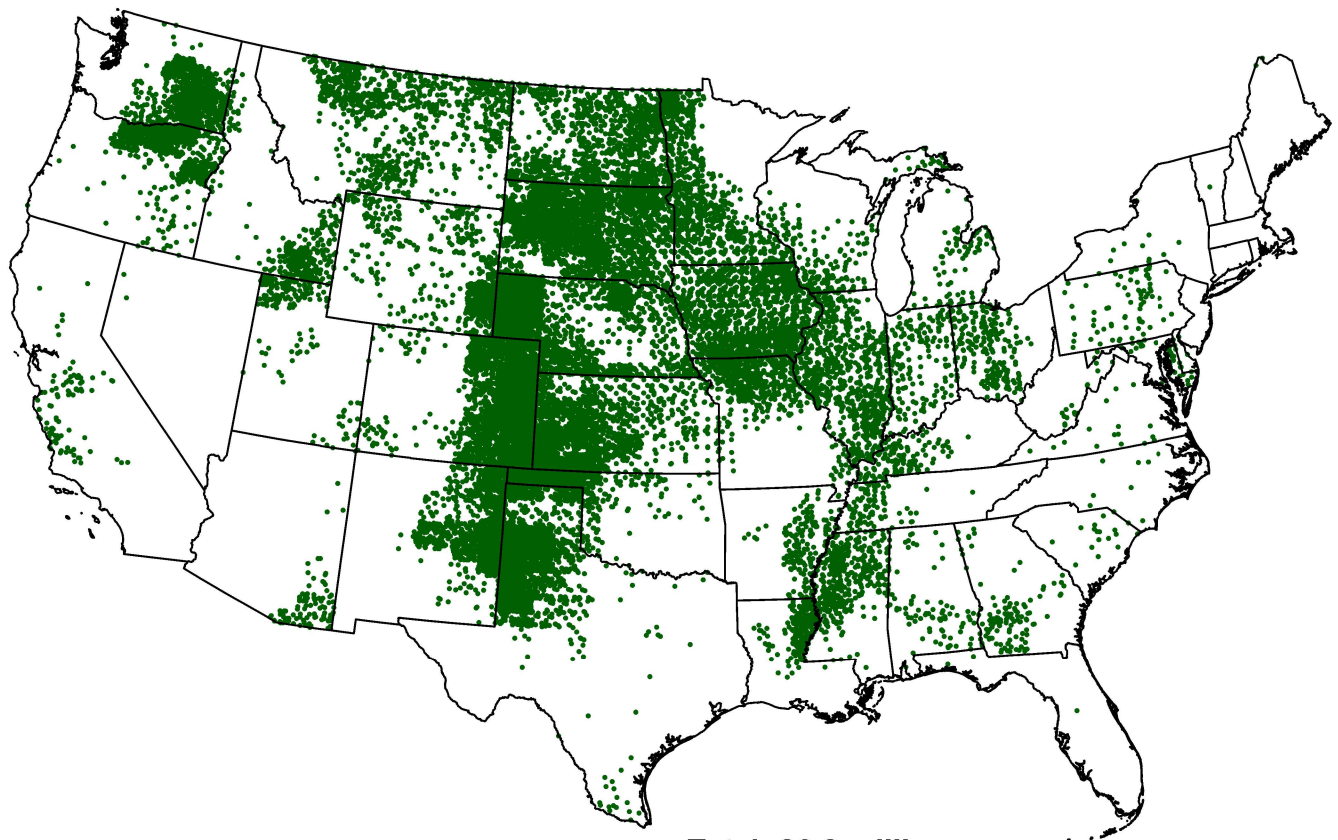
Highly Erodible Lands Initiative (HELI). Producers take environmentally sensitive, erosion-prone land out of production and establish grass or tree cover to maintain the long-term health of the land. It targets areas with a high Erodibility Index.

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The accompanying tables are based on contract data developed and maintained in CRP data files by USDA Service Centers through the **end of May 2026** and are based on the physical location of the CRP contracted land. Some adjustments have been made to correct miscoded data in the active contract files.

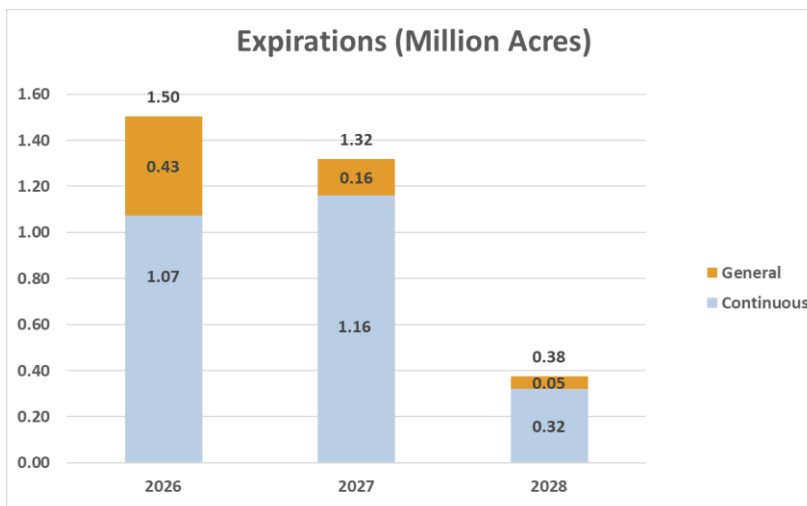

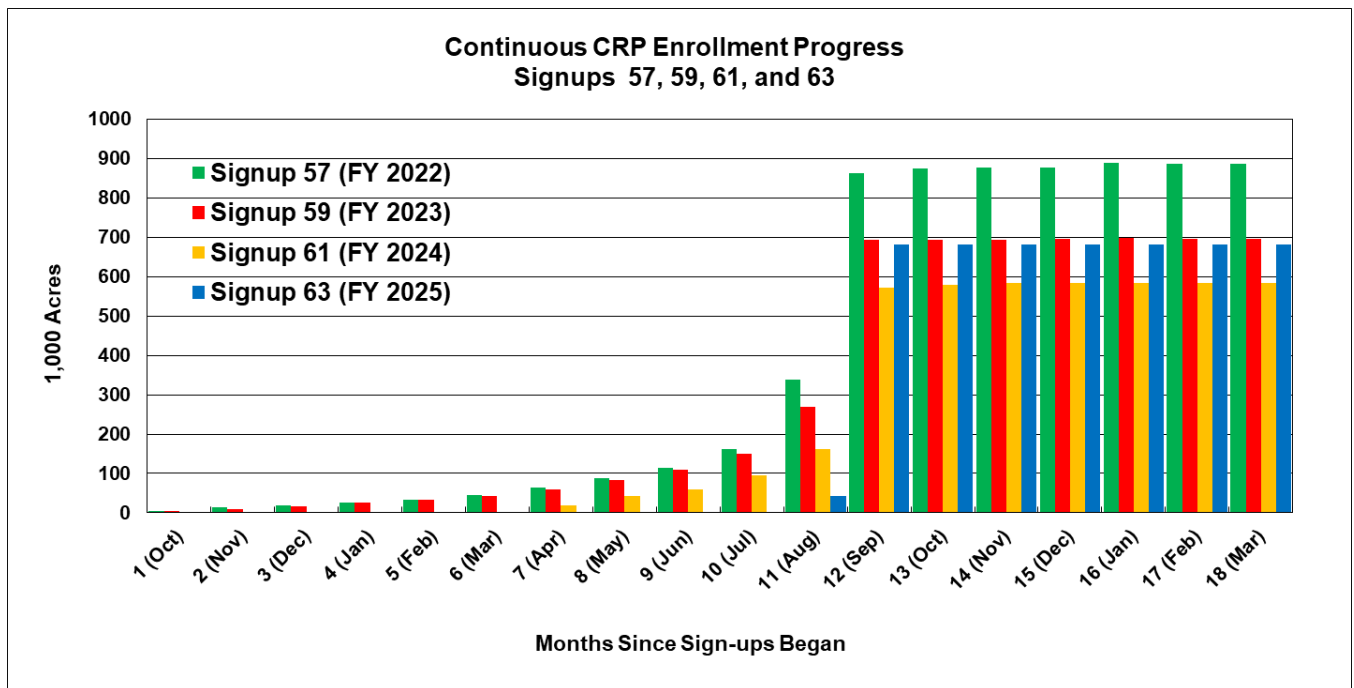

CONSERVATION RESERVE PROGRAM

ENROLLMENT ACTIVITY AND NEWS – May 2026

- Enrollment ends May 2026 at 26.2 million acres.
- FY 2026 continuous signup (#65) opened February 12, 2026. To ensure the acreage enrolled does not exceed the statutory limitation, continuous signup offers were placed in a batch process. The first batching period closed March 20, 2026, and 819,872 acres were accepted. The second batching period opened on March 23, 2026 and will run through May 1, 2026.
- General signup (#66) opened March 9, 2026. The signup period closed on April 17, 2026, and 325,244 acres were accepted. These contracts will become effective October 1, 2026.
- Grasslands signup (#208) opened May 4, 2026 and will run through May 29, 2026.



Signup 63 enrollment peaked at 683,287 acres.
