2019 Acreage Reporting Dates

Producers must file accurate and timely crop acreage reports for all crops and land uses, including failed acreage, in order to prevent the potential loss of FSA program benefits.

The following acreage reporting dates are applicable for Carbon and Albany Counties:

July 15, 2019: Grass for grazing, Grass for Hay, Alfalfa, Corn, Wheat, Barley, Oats

The following exceptions apply to the above acreage reporting dates:

- If the crop has not been planted by the above acreage reporting date, then the crop acreage must be reported no later than 15 calendar days after planting is completed.
- If a producer acquires additional crop acreage after the above acreage reporting date, then the crop acreage must be reported no later than 30 calendar days after purchase or acquiring the lease. Appropriate documentation of how and when the crop acreage was acquired must be provided to the county office.

Producers interested in receiving acreage credit must report crop acreage they intended to plant, but due to natural disaster, were prevented from planting. Prevented planting acreage must be reported on form CCC-576, *Notice of Loss*, within 15 calendar days after the final planting date as established by FSA and the Risk Management Agency (RMA). For producers with Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program (NAP) coverage, the acreage

reporting date for NAP-covered crops is the earlier of the dates listed above or 15 calendar days before grazing or harvesting of the crop begins.
