This program is for those producers who had/have alfalfa hay, barley, canola, corn, dried beans, dry peas, lentils, millet, oats, rye, chickpeas, sorghum, soybeans, sunflowers, triticale, wheat, dairy and/or hogs for the 2019 crop year. Please call ahead for an appointment to sign up. MFP signup runs through December 6th.

If you have a CRP contract that is expiring this year; you should have received a letter regarding a one-year extension. The deadline to sign up for the extension is this Friday (August 23, 2019). Please call for an appointment ASAP!

Marketing Assistance Loans are available for harvested 2019 wheat. Please call the office if you are interested in taking a loan, or would like more information on this program.

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## Maintaining the Quality of Farm-Stored Loan Grain

Bins are ideally designed to hold a level volume of grain. When bins are overfilled and grain is heaped up, airflow is hindered and the chance of spoilage increases.

Producers who take out marketing assistance loans and use the farm-stored grain as collateral should remember that they are responsible for maintaining the quality of the grain through the term of the loan.

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## Attention all Buyers of Agricultural Products

It is required that buyers of agricultural products check or register with the Secretary of State's Office to determine if there are liens against the Seller of the product. If a lien is found you are required to place the lien holders name on the check as well as that of the Seller. Ag Products include but are not limited to: livestock (including horses), crops used for feed (hay, silage, oats, etc.), machinery, equipment and all other crops. **Failure to place the lien holder's name on the check may result in civil legal action being taken against the Buyer of the product.
