Acres Reports:

- December 15 - Fall seeded small grains. Example: Barley, Oats, Rye, Wheat (Preceding year)
- January 15 - Peaches, Canola
- July 15 - Perennial Forage, CRP, all other crops

ARC/PLC: August 1 for annual enrollment

• **Crops With NAP Coverage:**

- Sept. 30 - Aquaculture; Value loss and controlled environment crops (except Nursery). Examples: Christmas Trees, Crustaceans, Finfish, Flowers, Ginseng, Grass Sod **Preceding Year (Report 2019 for 2020)**
- January 2 - Honey (Same Crop Year)
- May 31 - Nursery **Preceding Year (Report 2019 for 2020)**

All Other NAP Crops are to be reported the earlier of: the Acreage Reporting Dates above (or) 15 calendar days before the onset of harvest.

NAP Coverage Application Closing Dates

Eligible producers must apply for coverage and pay the applicable service fees annually by the application closing date. Acreage reports are also due annually. To ensure coverage availability, please call your local office.

Marketing Assistance Loans and Loan Deficiency Payments:

- March 31 - for prior year harvested wheat, barley, canola, crambe, flaxseed, honey, oats, rapeseed, and sesame
- May 31 - for prior year harvested corn, soybeans and other oilseeds, rice, grain sorghum, and pulse crops
- Jan. 31 - for prior year harvested peanuts, wool, mohair and LDP only for unshorn pelts

CRP - Contact your county office for general and continuous CRP sign up information.
