Matt Gellings State Executive Director USDA, Farm Service Agency Boise, Idaho

Matt Gellings was appointed by the Biden Administration to serve as the State Executive Director of the USDA Farm Service Agency (FSA) in Idaho in January 2022.

Gellings was a fourth-generation farmer who grew alfalfa, wheat, malt barley, and potatoes in Idaho Falls and maintained a cattle operation for 26 years. He served a total of 12 years on Idaho FSA's State Committee under both the Obama and Trump administrations.

Gellings has served in several leadership roles for agriculture organizations in Idaho including chairman of the Leadership Idaho Agriculture Board of Trustees, president of the Eastern Idaho Ag Hall of Fame, and president of the Bonneville County Grain Producers Association.

He studied marketing and mid-management at Boise State University.

Gellings has a son, daughter, and five grandchildren and his wife Kathy has a son, all of whom live in Idaho. Gellings and Kathy plan to travel back to their farm in eastern Idaho often.
